On 8 March 2022, the European Commission published a proposal for an EU Directive on combating violence against women and domestic violence, aiming to support and protect victims/survivors, guarantee access to justice, and hold offenders to account. As civil society practitioners, and direct and indirect respondents to gender-based violence (GBV), the PROSPERA Network of Women's Funds Europe (WFE) and the Women Against Violence Europe (WAVE) Network are committed to ensuring that the voice of feminist civil society is heard and actively included in the proposed EU Directive. We call on policymakers to build on civil society's gender-responsive expertise in specialist support service provision and expert analysis to strengthen the Directive. This will enhance the text and its future implementation by adopting a *whole of society approach* to holistically address GBV against Women, enshrining victims/survivor rights and protection beyond criminal proceedings.

This webinar will examine the following issues:

- The role of civil society and feminist organisations in ensuring GBV holistic prevention and victims/survivor rights' protection.
- 2. Fostering coordination among Member States and EU Institutions with women's civil society organisations (CSOs) to include feminist organisations as implementing partners and ensure the gendersensitive implementation of the Directive.
- 3. The value of a pilot baseline assessment to identify promising practices and common policy objectives for women's CSOs in the implementation of the EU Directive on GBV against women.
