





MOVING WOMEN FORWARD: MOVEMENT BUILDING TO END VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN AND FOR FEMINIST PEACE

We are delighted to share with you the results of the project "Moving Women Forward: Movement building to end violence against women and for feminist peace", funded by the European Union through the WAVE Regranting Pilot Initiative 2023. This collaborative effort was led by the Mediterranean Institute of Gender Studies (MIGS) in partnership with the Association of Women to Support Living (KAYAD).

Project Overview

The post conflict environment in Cyprus has maintained that gender equality policy, and particularly policies to prevent and combat violence against women, are peripheral issues to the Cypriot political context. Women on both sides of the island continue to face discrimination in all areas of life, and there is a high prevalence of domestic violence, femicide and trafficking. However, there are little to no mechanisms supporting bicommunal and/or cross-island collaboration on these issues. The Moving Women Forward project aimed at providing a platform for MIGS and KAYAD to collaborate across the divide to advocate for an end to violence against women and domestic violence in Cyprus.

Key Deliverables and Outcomes

1. Comparative report on domestic violence against women in Cyprus

The project produced the first island-wide comprehensive report outlining the existing Policy Framework and Recommendations for Addressing Domestic Violence Against Women in Cyprus.

2. Podcasts on gender equality and violence against women

Six engaging podcasts were produced in Greek, Turkish, and English, covering topics such as gender stereotypes, domestic violence, and challenges faced by the women's movement.
